

LOGAN ELM HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE

ACCREDITED BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE NORTH CENTRAL ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS

NAME – Logan Elm High School is named in honor of an American Elm tree that was made famous when the Mingo Indian Chief, Logan, delivered a classic oration under its branches in 1774.

FACULTY – The staff is composed of 40 teachers, two counselors, three secretaries, two monitors, three custodians, a librarian, a library technician, an athletic director, an assistant principal and a principal. The average number of years teaching experience is 15. Seventy-five percent have a master’s degree.

RATIO – The on-campus teacher-student ratio for 2007-2008 was 17.8 to one; the counselor-student ratio was 344 to one.

INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM - There are 15 departments offering 125 different courses over 240 teaching periods. Some classes are arranged on a block schedule. The majority of classes meet for a 48 minute traditional session. The remainder employ a 90 minute block per semester. A combined venture with the Pickaway-Ross Career & Technology Center provides one tech-prep program. Students attending the career center may choose from 20 specialty areas.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS – Students must earn 22 credits to graduate. Subject area requirements include: four English, three social studies, three math, three science and one health/physical education.

GRADING – To receive credits, five points must be earned in each class and the second semester must be passed.

LIBRARY – Our library contains 9,809 items of which 4,609 are nonfiction, 279 are biographical, 3044 are fiction, 636 are reference and 567 are non-print media. Attendance averaged over 234 per day. Total expenditures for 2007-2008 were \$3,500.00.

STUDENT DATA – The current student body consists of 784 students, of this group 94 attend the Pickaway-Ross Career & Technology Center.
